- 1948 Studied Art Department, Taiwan Normal University, Taipei
- 1958 Apply to be a professor at NTUA, PCCU, MCU of Art, Taiwan
- 1968 Invited to participate in the International Sculptors Association
- 1977 Dean of the Dharma Realm Buddhist University of Art
- 1992 Founded the Yuyu Yang Museum
- 1993 Founded Yuyu Yang Art & Education Foundation
- 1995 Appointed as director of the National Culture and Arts Foundation
Selected as the first international fellow of the Royal Society of Sculptors
- 1997 Deceased in Hsinchu, Fayuan Temple, Taiwan
